WINTER MISSION PROJECT

Members and friends of the Congregation are invited to join the Faith Builder classes in a local mission project that supports the Portage Chapter of the national nonprofit organization, Sleep In Heavenly Peace (SHP). Portage's SHP/ Sleep in Heavenly Peace builds bunk beds for children, living in Columbia and surrounding counties, who go without their own beds. During December thru February, we will collect new books and new stuffed animals for children and youth who receive beds. There is a special need for teen chapter books, but all donations of new items are appreciated. Please avoid buying Christmas-themed books or toys. A collection bin will be at the back of the Sanctuary. We will make you aware of other Volunteer opportunities when they become available later this winter, spring and summer.

FEBRUARY SERMON SERIES

We will be continuing our "walk" through "The Gospel" of Isaiah, seeing how so much of Jesus' ministry was prophesied some 700 years before God the Son came to earth.

- **Feb. 2 "Four Chaplains Sunday"** We will remember the four military chaplains who saved many lives by their own sacrifices before going down with the ship, praying and singing praises to God, locked arm in arm. The Sacrament of Holy Communion will be served at the altar. We will consider both God's sovereignty and salvation as we look at Isaiah 45:18-25. "There is no other god besides me, a righteous God and a Savior; there is no one besides me. Turn to me and be saved..."
- **Feb. 9** "Why is God better than a horoscope?" That might seem like a strange question to ask, but it is relevant and has parallel applications to many areas of life. Isaiah 47:8-15 and 49:17-18 and surrounding verses are not as unimportant as a first reading might suggest!
- **Feb. 16 St. Valentine's Day Weekend** and we remember God saying, "I Will Not Forget You." See Isaiah 49:13-16 for the full account of this wonderful promise. Special music by Phil Sommers and Dennis Wopat.
- **Feb. 23 Transfiguration Sunday**. This is the Sunday before Ash Wednesday and we begin an in-depth look at Isaiah 53. Today we focus on the first three verses of this incredible picture of Jesus' death! Jesus identifies Himself with us! And that makes His Transfiguration before Peter, James, and John all the more remarkable and meaningful.

ASH WEDNESDAY EVENING SERVICE

Wed. Feb. 26 at 7:00 p.m.

This service will be different than the mid-day service that we host annually for the Pardeeville Area Ecumenical Churches. See the details for that service in the other Ash Wednesday article. The evening service will include the option of receiving ashes on the forehead or palm if you so desire. Come and worship and be ushered into the forty days of Lent as a special time of drawing closer to the Lord as we remember our own frailty and constant need of God's grace.



The Pardeeville area Pastors' Fellowship is again planning the annual "Soup & Sandwich & Service" for the Sunday evenings of Lent. This year's Lenten theme is "The Cross-Shaped Life." The evenings will begin at 6:00 pm with a soup & sandwich meal, followed by interdenominational worship with our brothers and sisters in Christ throughout the Pardeeville area. Thank you to everyone who donated new stuffed animals and books to the Portage Chapter of SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE/SHP, which builds beds for children who don't have their own beds. The stuffed toys and books will given to each child when the beds are delivered. **Collection will continue thru February 23**.

PORTAGE CHAPTER OF SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE OFFERS VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES.

The mission statement of this non-profit organization is "NO CHILD SHALL SLEEP WITHOUT A BED IN OUR TOWN". Youth (aged 13 years and older, who must be accompanied by a legal guardian) and adult volunteers are needed to help build beds. They will be guided by skilled SHP workers in building bunk-beds for children who do not have their own beds. The next BUILD DAY is tentatively set for February 29th. More "Builds" will occur April thru November. Specific Dates will be announced on the Portage Chapter's SHP Facebook site (www.facebook.com/SHPPortage/) and we'll announce the specific dates in the Church Bulletin and Newsletter as the BUILD DAYS are set. Most "builds" are at the SHP Warehouse in Portage.

Each volunteer is required to fill out an "Indemnification Release Form" online or complete this form on the "Build Day". Parents or Guardians must fill out this form for Youth who are age 13 years and older. No child who is 12-years-old or younger may participate on a Build Day.


