Minutes of the Administrative Board of the Pardeeville United Methodist Church September 11, 2019

In attendance: Doug Hare, Joyce Hare, Pastor Kerry Wilson, Sue Wilson, Chuck Janisch, Kathy Sommers, Patsy Villwock, Jenny Reilly, Beth Gallagher, Ken Taylor, Joann Dalton, Kim Sieber

Chairman Doug Hare called the meeting to order and Pastor Kerry prayed for the meeting.

Minutes of the August meeting were approved after Joyce Hare made the motion to do so and Chuck Janisch seconded.

Treasurer's Report_— Jenny Reilly explained that the software has never been reconciled with the bank statement since 2017 or before. Kim Sieber stated that the 2017 records are in the church office. Jenny also said she needs a better understanding of apportionments. She has not paid out any of the funds that have been designated for apportionments yet because she does not know how to go about that. She did think that John Klare may have made some apportionment payments earlier in the year before Jenny took over being Treasurer. Because she is unsure of the exact balance in the account, she said she is hesitant to pay out any large amounts.

Kim Sieber made a motion that was seconded by Kathy Sommers that we designate our apportionments for General Conference. This motion carried.

The subject of Pastor Kerry's mileage being at the point now of going over budget due to hospital visits was brought up. Beth Gallagher made a motion stating that Pastor's travel is necessary and we as an administrative board will OK exceeding the budget. Ken Taylor seconded and the motion carried.

Ken Taylor moved to accept the financial report and Kim Sieber seconded. The motion carried.

Pastor's Report – Our annual Charge Conference has been set for Tues., Nov. 19 at 6:30 p.m. Place will be announced at a later date. This will be a joint Charge Conference with Pardeeville UMC, Portage UMC, Lodi, Arlington-Poynette Inch, and North Windsor.

"Review of Local Church's Life and Ministry" Form was given to everyone in attendance. Pastor suggested that ad board members make notes and return to Doug Hare by the Oct. 23^{rd.} meeting

"How to Navigate the Next 12 Months" will be the theme of the District Superintendent Scott Carlson's address during charge conference.

Trustees Report – The parsonage and church mailboxes are both leaning. This will be fixed.

Edging of the lawn along sidewalks is being addressed.

Work is being done to take care of the garden along Chestnut St.

Discussion was held regarding professional treatment of bugs and mice

Finance Committee Report – Next meeting scheduled for Sept. 30 at 6:30 p.m.

Change of banks: Polly Vilstrup knows that the Memorial account needs to be moved from the National Exchange Bank to the Hometown Bank.

Kim Sieber and Ken Taylor have not checked the safe deposit box yet. They will do this and determine whether the things there could be put in the church safe or kept at the bank.

A new checking account was opened at Hometown Bank for the HOPE account by Joyce Hare, who be a signatory and Wanda Williams, who will be the treasurer for that account. The remainder of the money from UMW was deposited into this account.

A new chairperson for this committee is being sought.

Staff-Parish Relations Committee – Meetings are scheduled for Sept. 12 and Sept. 25.

Staff evaluations are in process.

Discipleship Committee – Next meeting will be in November. No specific date set yet.

Memorial Committee – No report. A new chairperson is being sought.

Missions Committee – No meeting scheduled at this time.

Christian Education – VBS was successful. We had several new children and families, along with many of our "regulars."

The first day of "Faith Builders", there were 51 in attendance. This included parents of the confirmation class, children from nursery through confirmation, and the adult class studying the book <u>Killing Kryptonite</u>.

There was a meeting on Sun, Sept. 8. A different mission project from last year will be chosen. Work is being done to choose a Christmas program.

"Candles and Carols" is currently scheduled for Sunday evening, Dec. 1. Cheryl Thomson requested that the 3rd-6th graders possibly sing. At this Ad Board meeting, it was noted that this date is the last day of deer hunting

season as well as the 4th day of Thanksgiving break.

There was also a discussion Re: children rushing to coffee fellowship and taking too much food, some of which is thrown into the trash because of time limits.

The suggestion was made that the published time for Coffee Fellowship should be modified to read "Coffee Fellowship Following the Worship Service" rather than at 10:15, as 10:15 is the time when "Faith Builders" starts.

Lay Speakers – There is a retreat at Pine Lake the last weekend of September where many classes will be offered.

Young and Youth Adventures – Beth Gallagher reports that she is looking at the potential for 67 kids plus families! Estimates: 12 in K-4, 12 5th graders, 17 6th-8th graders, and up to 15 High schoolers.

Sky Lodge is available on October 16. Arrangements need to be made with Smith Bus Company. We will take supper along rather than having the camp provide food.

Reservations have been made with Cascade Mountain for tubing on January 8. This will be a fund-raiser as well as a fun event.

Saturday, November 2 is the Holiday on the Lake breakfast, bake sale and craft sale. This is a fund-raiser for Y/ YA. Proceeds from the Bake Sale will be used for scholarships. Proceeds from Breakfast will cover Y/YA expenses. Proceeds from the sale of decorative boards painted by our youth will help pay for expenses for youth to attend a QUAKE conference in Wisconsin Dells in March. The scholarship and Quake funds will go into the HOPE account and the breakfast proceeds will go into the Youth checking account that Dawn Gillingham is treasurer of.

Old Business – Turkey Supper Oct. 19

Turkeys are ordered and will be here Oct. 14

Cranberries have been ordered

There have been requests for tickets already. Kim Sieber will print posters and tickets soon.

Prices will remain the same this year as last year.

Ads will go into the Rio and Pardeeville Shoppers.

Joyce will contact potential ad sponsors. Jenny Reilly estimated that the cost for advertising might be about \$44 for Rio and \$168 for Pardeeville based on figures she could see from last year.

We adjourned at 8:18 p.m. with the Lord's Prayer.


